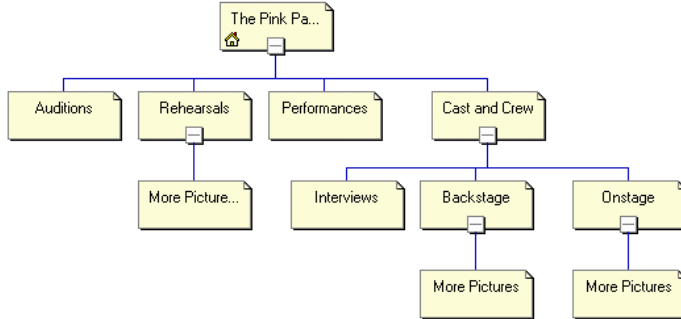


# Math—A State of Mine

4. Write the filename you will use in the space below the box.


